Following on from our recent internal parent survey on internet usage and devices, as well as the recent introduction of phone lockers for our Y7 students, this evening is designed to best equip parents with knowledge and confidence in addressing eSafety issues that their son or daughter faces in the digital sphere. This evening is part of our ongoing programme of working in partnership with parents, now broadening to parents across the islands. Primarily aimed at parents of boys and girls in Y4-6 from across the island, the evening will include identifying the main risks your son or daughter will face online, and how to address them with your child. The evening will be a chance to discuss the major risks to safeguarding and wellbeing in our young people, some of the ways schools are seeking to address them, and how as the adults in the conversation we can work together. The Senior Safeguarding Team from Victoria College will share important information and terminology to best equip parents in supporting and protecting their sons from some of the greatest online risk factors.
